

Congregation Notes Balak Calls for Messiah's Coming are Increasing and 2nd Session Gog and Magog is Coming July 12,2025; Tammuz 16, 5785 Numbers 22:2-25:9;Micah 5:6-6:8; Matthew 21:1-11

*Numbers 22:1-6 Then the children of Israel moved and camped in the plains of Moab on the side of the Jordan across from Jericho. 2Now Balak the son of Zippor saw all that Israel had done to the Amorites. 3And Moab was exceedingly afraid of the people because they were many, and Moab was sick with dread because of the children of Israel. 4So Moab said to the elders of Midian, Now this company will lick up everything around us, as an ox licks up the grass of the field. And Balak the son of Zippor was king of the Moabites at that time.

*Numbers 21:22-35 Then Israel sent messengers to Sihon king of the Amorites, saying, Let me pass through your land. We will not turn aside into fields or vineyards; we will not drink water from wells. We will go by the King's Highway until we have passed through your territory. But <u>Sihon would not allow Israel to pass through his territory</u>. So Sihon gathered all his people together and went out against Israel in the wilderness, and he came to Jahaz and fought against Israel. <u>24</u>Then Israel defeated him with the edge of the sword, and took possession of his land from the Arnon to the Jabbok, as far as the people of Ammon; for the border of the people of Ammon was fortified. <u>25</u>So Israel took all these cities, and Israel dwelt in all the cities of the Amorites, in Heshbon and in all its villages...... <u>33</u>And they turned and went up by the way to Bashan. So Og king of Bashan went out against them, he and all his people, to battle at Edrei. <u>34</u>Then the LORD said to Moses, Do not fear him, for I have delivered him into your hand, with all his people and his land; and you shall do to him as you did to Sihon king of the Amorites, who dwelt at Heshbon. <u>35</u>So <u>they defeated</u> him, his sons, and all his people, until there was no survivor left him; and they took possession of his land.

*Numbers 22:5-6 Then he sent messengers to Balaam the son of Beor at Pethor,.... saying: "Look, a people has come from Egypt. See, they cover the face of the earth, and are settling next to me! Therefore <u>please come at once, curse this people for me, for they are too</u> <u>mighty for me</u>. Perhaps I shall be able to defeat them and drive them out of the land, for <u>I</u> <u>know that he whom you bless is blessed, and he whom you curse is cursed</u>.

*Proverbs 16:24 Kind words are like honey - sweet to the soul and healthy for the body.

*Proverbs 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue,

*Numbers 22:6 Come now, <u>curse this people for me</u>, since they are too mighty for me. Perhaps I shall be able to defeat them and drive them from the land, for I know that he whom you bless is blessed, and <u>he whom you curse is cursed</u>.

*Numbers 22:7 So the elders of Moab and the elders of Midian departed with the fees for divination in their hand. And they came to Balaam and gave him Balak's message.

*Numbers 22:8 Spend the night here, Balaam replied, and I will give you the answer that the LORD speaks to me. So the princes of Moab stayed with Balaam....

*Numbers 22:22 And <u>flare did God's anger</u> and there stood <u>the angel of the LORD</u> on the road <u>as an impediment</u> to him.

*Numbers 23:7-10 And he took up his oracle and said: Balak the king of Moab has brought me from Aram,

From the mountains of the east. Come, curse Jacob for me,

And come, denounce Israel!⁸ How shall I curse whom God has not cursed? And how shall I whom the Lord has not denounced? For from the top of the rocks I see him, And from the hills I behold him; There! A people dwelling alone,

Not reckoning itself among the nations.

*Romans 11:29 for the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.

continuing with Numbers 23:10 Who can count the dust of Jacob,

*Genesis 28:14 Your descendants will be like the dust of the earth, and you will spread out to the west and east and north and south. All the families of the earth will be blessed through you and your offspring.

^{continuing with Numbers 23:10} Or number one-fourth of Israel? Let me die the death of the righteous, And let my end be like his!

*Ezekiel 37:21 And say to them, This is what the Sovereign Lord says: I will take the Israelites out of the nations where they have gone. <u>I will gather them from all around and bring them back into their own land</u>.

*Zechariah 12:3 Moreover, on that day I will make Jerusalem a heavy burden for all the nations, and all who try to carry it will be seriously injured; yet all the peoples of the earth will be assembled against it.

***Isaiah 35:10** And the ransomed of the Lord shall return and come to Zion with singing; everlasting joy shall be upon their heads; they shall obtain gladness and joy, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

*Numbers 23:19-20;23-24 God is not a man, that He should lie, Nor a son of man, that He should repent. <u>Has He said, and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it</u> good? Behold, I have received a command to bless; He has blessed, and I cannot reverse it.

*Numbers 23:23 For there is no sorcery against Jacob,

Nor any divination against Israel. It now must be said of Jacob And of Israel, <u>Oh, what God</u> <u>has done</u>!

*2 Timothy 3:8-9 and specifically 8 Just as <u>Jannes and Jambres opposed Moses</u>, so <u>these men also oppose the truth</u>, men corrupted in mind and disqualified regarding the faith. But they will not get very far, for their folly will be plain to all, as was that of those two men.

*Numbers 23:24 Look, <u>a people rises like a lioness</u>, <u>And lifts itself up like a lion</u>; It shall not lie down until it devours the prey, And drinks the blood of the slain.

*Isaiah 63:1-4 Who is this who comes from Edom, With dyed garments from Bozrah, This One who is glorious in His apparel, Traveling in the greatness of His strength?—I who speak in righteousness, mighty to save.

• Isaiah 34:6 For the LORD has a sacrifice in Bozrah, a great slaughter in the land of Edom.

*Jeremiah 49:13 soundly predicts permanent devastation: "Bozrah will become a desolation, a reproach, a ruin, and a curse."

***Isaiah 63:1-3** Who is this coming from Edom, from Bozrah with crimson-stained garments? Who is this robed in splendor, marching in the greatness of His strength? It is I, proclaiming vindication, mighty to save. Why is Your apparel red, And Your garments like one who treads in the winepress? I have trodden the winepress alone, And from the peoples no one was with Me. For I have trodden them in My anger and trampled them in My fury; Their blood is sprinkled upon My garments, and I have stained all My robes. For the day of vengeance is in My heart, and the year of My redeemed has come.

*Luke 1:32-33 He will be great, he will be called Son of Ha Elyon, The Lord. God, will give him the throne of his forefather David; and <u>He will rule the House of Yaakov forever</u> — there will be <u>no end to his Kingdom</u>.

*Numbers 24:17-19 "I see Him, but not now; I behold Him, but not near; A Star shall come out of Jacob;

A Scepter shall rise out of Israel, And batter the brow of Moab, And destroy all the sons of tumult. And <u>Edom shall be a possession</u>; <u>Seir also, his enemies, shall be a possession</u>, While Israel does valiantly. <u>Out of Jacob One shall have dominion</u>,

*Matthew 21:1b-5 Jesus sent two disciples, saying to them, Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied, and a colt with her. Loose them and bring them to Me. And if anyone says anything to you, you shall say, The Lord has need of them, and immediately he will send them.

All this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying:

Tell the daughter of Zion, <u>Behold, your King is coming to you,</u> <u>Lowly, and sitting on a donkey</u>, A colt, the foal of a donkey.

*Luke 6:27-29 But to those of you who will listen, I say: <u>Love your enemies</u>, <u>do good to</u> <u>those who hate you</u>, <u>bless those who curse you</u>, <u>pray for those who mistreat you</u>. If someone strikes you on one cheek, turn to him the other also. And if someone takes your cloak, do not withhold your tunic as well....

***Psalm 83:1-2** A Song, a Psalm of Asaph. <u>G-d, do not keep silent</u>. Do not hold Your peace, O G-d. Do not be still.

*Psalm 83:3 For look, Your enemies make an uproar. Those who hate You lift up their head.

*Daniel 10:2 In those days, I, Daniel was mourning for three whole weeks.

*Daniel 10:12-14 Then he said to me, Don't be afraid, Daniel! For from the first day that you set your heart to understand and to humble yourself before your God, your <u>words were heard</u>. I have come because of your words. However, the <u>of the kingdom of Persia resisted me for</u> <u>21 days</u>, but behold <u>Michael</u>, <u>one of the chief princes</u>, <u>came to help me because I had</u> <u>been detained there with the kings of Persia</u>. Now I have come to explain to you <u>what will</u> <u>happen to your people in the future days</u>. For the vision concerns days yet to come.

*Revelation 12:7-9 And <u>there was war in heaven</u>: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels, And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven. And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceives the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and <u>his angels were</u> cast out with him.

***Psalm 83:4** They make a shrewd plot against Your people, conspiring against Your treasured ones.

***Psalm 83:5** Come, they say, let's wipe them out as a nation! Let Israel's name be remembered no more!

*Psalm 83:6 For with one mind they plot together. Against You do they make a covenant.

***Daniel 9:27** And <u>he will confirm a covenant with many for one week</u>, but in the middle of the week he will put an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of the temple will come the abomination that causes desolation, until the decreed destruction is poured out upon him.

***Psalm 83:7-9** The tents of Edom and the Ishmaelites, Moab and the Hagrites, Gebal, Ammon and Amalek, Philistia with the inhabitants of Tyre, even Assyria has joined them, becoming a strong arm for Lot's sons.

*Psalm 83:10 Do to them as to Midian; as to Sisera, as to Jabin at the brook Kishon.

*Judges 4:14 Barak, it's time to attack Sisera! Because today <u>the LORD is going to help you</u> <u>defeat him</u>. In fact, <u>the LORD has already gone on ahead to fight for you</u>.

***I John 3:8** The one who practices sin is of the devil, because the devil has been sinning from the very start. This is why the Son of God was revealed, <u>to destroy the works of the devil</u>.

*Revelation 12:9 And the great dragon was thrown down, the serpent of old who is called the devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; <u>he was thrown down to the earth</u>, <u>and his</u> <u>angels were thrown down with him</u>.

*Ephesians 2:2 in which you formerly walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, of <u>the spirit that is now working in the sons of</u> <u>disobedience</u>.

***Psalm 83:13-14;16&18** ...Let us take possession of the pasturelands of G-d. May G-d, make them like tumbleweed, like chaff before the wind. As a fire burns a forest, as a flame sets mountains ablaze..... so pursue them with your tempest and terrify them with Your storm.....So they may know that You whose name alone is the LORD, are the Most High over all the earth.

*Isaiah 24:21 In that day the LORD will punish the powers in the heavens above and the kings on the earth below.
