The Words Telling Us Messiah's Coming is Near
Aug.2, 2025; Av 8.5785
Deut. 1:1-3:22; Isa. 1:1-27; Mat. 24:1-22

***Exodus 4:10** But Moses said to the LORD, “Oh, my Lord, I am not eloquent, either in the past or since you have spoken to your servant, but I am slow of speech and slow of tongue.”

***Jeremiah 1:6** “Ah, Lord GOD,” I said, “I surely do not know how to speak, for I am only a child!”

***I Corinthians 2:1-2** When I came to you, brothers, I did not come with eloquence or wisdom as I proclaimed to you the testimony about God.....

***Acts 4:13** When they saw the boldness of Peter and John and realized that they were unschooled, ordinary men, they marveled and took note that these men had been with Yeshua.

***Isaiah 50:4** The Lord GOD has given Me the tongue of discipleship, to sustain the weary with a word. He awakens Me morning by morning; He awakens My ear to listen as a disciple.

***Isaiah 50:5-6** The Lord God has opened My ear; And I was not rebellious, Nor did I turn away. ⁶I gave My back to those who struck Me, And My cheeks to those who plucked out the beard; I did not hide My face from shame and spitting.

***2 Corinthians 12:9-10** But He said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for My power is perfected in weakness.” Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly in my weaknesses, so that the power of Messiah may rest on me. / That is why, for the sake of Messiah, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

***Deuteronomy 1:1 1** These are the words which Moses spoke to all Israel on this side of the Jordan in the wilderness, in the plain opposite Suph, between Paran, Tophel, Laban, Hazeroth, and Dizahab. It is eleven days' journey from Horeb by way of Mount Seir to Kadesh Barnea.

***Numbers 1:1** Now the LORD spoke to Moses in the Wilderness of Sinai, in the tabernacle of meeting, on the first day of the second month, in the second year after they had come out of the land of Egypt, saying:

***Deuteronomy (Devarim) 1:3-4** Now it came to pass in the fortieth year, in the eleventh month, on the first day of the month, that Moses spoke to the children of Israel according to all that



the LORD had given him as commandments to them, ⁴ after he had killed Sihon king of the Amorites, who dwelt in Heshbon, and Og king of Bashan, who dwelt at Ashtaroth in Edrei.

***Deuteronomy 1:5** On the other side of the Jordan in the land of Moab, Moses began to explain this law, saying,

***Deuteronomy (Devarim) 1:28-33** ²⁸ Where can we go up? Our brethren have discouraged our hearts, saying, The people are greater and taller than we; the cities are great and fortified up to heaven; moreover, we have seen the sons of the Anakim there. ²⁹ “Then I said to you, ‘Do not be terrified, or afraid of them.’ ³⁰ The LORD your God, who goes before you, He will fight for you, according to all He did for you in Egypt before your eyes, ³¹ and in the wilderness where you saw how the Lord your God carried you, as a man carries his son, in all the way that you went until you came to this place.’ ³² Yet, for all that, you did not believe the Lord your God, ³³ who went in the way before you to search out a place for you to pitch your tents, to show you the way you should go, in the fire by night and in the cloud by day.

***Isaiah 41:10** “Do not fear, for I am with you.”

***Matthew 24:25** “Behold, I have told you in advance.”

***John 16:33** These things I have spoken to you, so that in Me you have peace. In the world you will have tribulation, but take courage, for I have overcome the world.

***Matthew 24:3** Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying, “Tell us, when will these things be? And what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?”

***Ephesians 1:21** far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that (age) which is to come.

***Matthew 24:4-8** ⁴ And Jesus answered and said to them: “Take heed that no one deceives you.’ ⁵ For many will come in My name, saying, ‘I am the Messiah,’ and will deceive many. ⁶ And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not troubled; for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. ⁷ For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be famines, pestilences and earthquakes in various places. ⁸ All these are the beginning of sorrows.

***Daniel 12:4** “But you, Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book until the time of the end; many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall increase.”



***Daniel 12:8-9** Although I heard, I did not understand. Then I said, “My lord, what shall be the end of these things?” ⁹ And he said, “Go your way, Daniel, for the words are closed up and sealed till the time of the end. 10 Many shall be purified, made white, and refined, but the wicked shall do wickedly, and none of the wicked shall understand, but the wise shall understand.

***Deuteronomy 1:29b, 30,31b,32** So do not be terrified, or afraid of them the LORD your God, who goes before you, He will fight for you,.....God carried you, as a man carries his son, in all the way that you went until you came to this place. Yet for all that, you did not believe the LORD your God.,

***Matthew 24:9** Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name’s sake.

***Matthew 24:10** And then many will be offended, will betray one another, and will hate one another.

***2Thessalonians 2:1-3** Now, brethren, concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our gathering together to Him, we ask you, not to be soon shaken in mind or troubled, either by spirit or by word or by letter, as if from us, as though the day of Messiah had come. ³ Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition,

***Matthew 24:9** Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name’s sake.

***Deuteronomy 3:1-3** Then we turned and went up the road to Bashan; and Og king of Bashan came out against us, he and all his people, to battle at Edrei. And the LORD said to me, Do not fear him, for I have delivered him and all his people and his land into your hand; you shall do to him as you did to Sihon king of the Amorites, who dwelt at Heshbon. So the LORD our God also delivered into our hands Og king of Bashan, with all his people, and we attacked him until he had no survivors remaining.

***Psalm 22:12** Many bulls surround me, strong bulls of Bashan encircle me.

***Revelation 20:10** Then the devil who fooled them will be thrown into the lake of fire burning with sulphur. The wild animal and the false prophet are already there. They will all be punished day and night forever.

***Matthew 24:11-12** Then many false prophets will rise up and deceive many. ¹² And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold.



***2 Thessalonians 2:3-4** Let no one deceive you in any way. For that day will not come, unless the rebellion comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction, **4** who opposes and exalts himself against every so-called god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, proclaiming himself to be God.

***Matthew 24:14** And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.

***Matthew 28:19-20** Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age. Amen.

***Matthew 1:1-2** And Yeshua went out and departed from the temple, and His disciples came up to show Him the buildings of the temple. And Yeshua said to them, Do you not see all these things? Assuredly, I say to you, not one stone shall be left here upon another, that shall not be thrown down.

***Matthew 24:15** Therefore, when you see the ‘abomination of desolation,’ spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place” (whoever reads, let him understand),

***Daniel 11:31** And forces shall be mustered by him, and they shall defile the sanctuary fortress; then they shall take away the daily sacrifices, and place there the abomination of desolation.

***Matthew 24:15.** ***Matthew 24:15.** Therefore when you see the ‘abomination of desolation,’ spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place(whoever reads, let him understand),

***Daniel 9:27,** And he will confirm a covenant with many for one week, but in the middle of the week he will put an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of the temple will come the abomination that causes desolation, until the decreed destruction is poured out upon him.

***2 Thessalonians 2:3-4** Let no one deceive you in any way. For that day will not come, unless the rebellion comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction, **4** who opposes and exalts himself against every so-called god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, proclaiming himself to be God.
