Succot Is a Harbinger for the War of Gog and Megog
Oct. 11, 2025; Tishrei 19, 5786
Lev. 22:26-23:44; Zech.14:1-21; Luke 2:1-20

- *Deuteronomy 16:14-15 And <u>you shall rejoice</u> in your feast, you and your son and your daughter, your male servant and your female servant and the Levite, the stranger and the fatherless and the widow, who are within your gates. ¹⁵ Seven days you shall keep a sacred feast to the LORD your God in the place which the LORD chooses, because the LORD your God will bless you in all your produce and in all the work of your hands, so that <u>you surely rejoice</u>.
- *Leviticus 23:41-41-43 You are to celebrate this as a <u>feast to the LORD</u> for seven days each year. This is a <u>permanent statute for the generations to come</u>; you are to celebrate it in the seventh month. <u>You are to dwell in booths for seven days.</u> All the native-born of Israel must dwell in booths, 43so that your descendants may know that I made <u>the Israelites dwell in booths when I brought them out of the land of Egypt.</u> I am the LORD your God.
- *Nehemiah 8:14-18 And they found written in the Law, which the LORD had commanded through Moses, that the Israelites were to dwell in booths during the feast of the seventh month, / and that they should proclaim this message and spread it throughout their towns and in Jerusalem, saying, "Go out to the hill country and bring back branches of olive, wild olive, myrtle, palm, and other leafy trees, to make booths, as it is written." / And the people went out, brought back branches, and made booths on their own rooftops, in their courtyards, in the courts of the house of God, and in the squares by the Water Gate and by the Gate of Ephraim. So the whole assembly of those who had returned from the captivity made booths and sat under the booths; for since the days of Joshua the son of Nun until that day the children of Israel had not done so. And there was very great gladness. Also day by day, from the first day until the last day, he read from the Book of the Law of God. And they kept the feast seven days; and on the eighth day there was a sacred assembly, according to the prescribed manner.
- * John 5:6-8 This is the One who came by water and blood, Yeshua the Messiah—<u>not by water alone, but by water and blood</u>. And it is the Spirit who testifies to this, because the Spirit is the truth. / For there are three that testify: / the <u>Spirit, the water, and the blood</u>—and these three are in agreement.
- *Matthew 26:27-29 Then He took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you. 28 This is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins. 29I tell you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it anew with you in My Father's kingdom."...
- *Isaiah 12:2-3 Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and will not be afraid; for the LORD God is my strength and my song, and He has become my salvation. With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.

- *John 7:2-4 Now the Jewish festival of Booths was near. So his brothers said to him, Leave here and go to Judea so that your disciples also may see the works you are doing; for no one who wants to be widely known acts in secret. If you do these things, show yourself to the world.
- *John 7:6-10 Then Jesus said to them, "My time has not yet come, but your time is always ready. 7The world cannot hate you, but it hates Me because I testify of it that its works are evil. 8 You go up to this feast. I am not yet going up to this feast, for My time has not yet fully come." 9When He had said these things to them, He remained in Galilee. 10But when His brothers had gone up, then He also went up to the feast, not openly, but as it were in secret.
- *John 7:28-31 Then Yeshua cried out, as He taught in the temple, saying, "You both know Me, and you know where I am from; and I have not come of Myself, but He who sent Me is true, whom you do not know. 29 But I know Him, for I am from Him, and He sent Me. "30 Therefore they sought to take Him; but no one laid a hand on Him, because His hour had not yet come. 31 And many of the people believed in Him, and said, "When the Messiah comes, will He do more signs than these which this Man has done?" 32 The Pharisees heard the crowd murmuring these things concerning Him, and the Pharisees and the chief priests sent officers to take Him.
- *John 7:40-41 Therefore many from the crowd, when they heard this saying, said, Truly, this is the Prophet. Others said, This is the Messiah. But some said, Will the Messiah come out of Galilee?
- *John 7:44-52 Some wanted to seize him, but no one laid a hand on him.⁴⁵ Finally the temple guards went back to the chief priests and the Pharisees, who asked them, Why didn't you bring him in? ⁴⁶ "No one ever spoke the way this man does, the guards replied. ⁴⁷ You mean he has deceived you also? the Pharisees retorted. ⁴⁸ Have any of the rulers or of the Pharisees believed in him? ⁴⁹ No! But this mob that knows nothing of the law—there is a curse on them. ⁵⁰ Nicodemus, who had gone to Yeshua earlier and who was one of their own number, asked, ⁵¹ Does our law condemn a man without first hearing him to find out what he has been doing? ⁵² They replied, Are you from Galilee, too? Look into it, and you will find that a prophet does not come out of Galilee.
- *John 7:37-38 On the last and greatest day of the festival, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, <u>Let anyone</u> who is thirsty come to Me and drink. Whoever believes in Me, as Scripture has said, <u>rivers of living water</u> will flow from within them.
- *Isaiah 55:1 Come, everyone who thirsts, come to the waters, and he who has no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without price.
- *Revelation 22:17 The Spirit and the Bride say, Come. And let the one who hears say, Come. And <u>let the</u> one who is thirsty come; let the one who desires take the water of life without price.
- *John 8:12 Once again, Yeshua spoke to the people and said, <u>I am the light of the world</u>. Whoever follows Me will never walk in the darkness, but will have the light of life.
- *John 3:8 The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but you do not know from where it comes and where it goes. Thus is everyone having been born of the Spirit.

- *Please save, for Your sake, our G-d, please save! Please save, for Your sake, our Creator, please save! Please save, for Your sake, our Redeemer, please save! Please save, for Your sake, our Attender, please save!
- *Zechariah 14:1-4&5b Behold, the day of the Lord is coming, And your spoil will be divided in your midst. ² For <u>I will gather all the nations to battle against Jerusalem</u>; ³ Then the LORD will go forth And fight against those nations, As He fights in the day of battle. ⁴ <u>And in that day His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives</u>, which faces Jerusalem on the east. And the Mount of Olives shall be split in two, from east to west, making a very large valley; Half of the mountain shall move toward the north And half of it toward the south...... thus the Lord my God will come, And all the saints with You.
- *Zechariah 14:16-17 'Then it will come about that any who are left of all the nations that went against Jerusalem will go up from year to year to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, and to celebrate the Feast of Booths'.
- *Zechariah 12:8-10 (compilation) teaches that the Lord, the Messiah, will come and save Israel from destruction at the hands of the nations of the world. At that time Israel will recognize her Messiah when "they shall look upon me whom they have pierced." At that time, Yeshua will be proclaimed "king over all the earth".
