THE POWER OF PRAYER AND COMING OF THE MESSIAH! ARE YOU READY?
Nov. 22, 2025; Kislev 2, 5786
Gen. 25:19-28:9; Malachi 1:1-2:7; Matt. 10:21-38

*Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

*Daniel 4:17 This decision is the decree of the watchers, the verdict declared by the holy ones, so that the living will know that the Most High rules over the kingdom of mankind and gives it to whom He wishes, setting over it the lowliest of men.

*Proverbs 16:33 The lot is cast into the lap, But its every decision is from the LORD.

*Romans 13:1 Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God.

*Genesis 6:9 These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God.

*Genesis 9:25 Then he said: Cursed be Canaan; A servant of servants He shall be to his brethren.

*Genesis 12:1 Now the Lord had said to Abram: Get out of your country, from your family and from your father's house, to a land that I will show you.

*Galatians 3:7-9 Understand, then, that those who have faith are sons of Abraham. / The Scripture foresaw that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, and foretold the gospel to Abraham: "All nations will be blessed through you." / So those who have faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.

*Genesis 18:1 And the LORD appeared to him in the plains of Mamre: and he sat in the tent door in the heat of the day;

*Genesis 49:30 The cave is in the field of Machpelah near Mamre, in the land of Canaan. This is the field Abraham purchased from Ephron the Hittite as a burial site. 31 There Abraham and his wife Sarah are buried, there Isaac and his wife Rebekah are buried, and there I buried Leah....

*Genesis 25:19-21 This is the genealogy of Isaac, Abraham's son. Abraham begot Isaac. 20 Isaac was forty years old when he took Rebekah as wife, the daughter of Bethuel the Syrian of Padan Aram, the sister of Laban the Syrian. 21 Now Isaac pleaded with the Lord for his wife, because she was barren;
FIRST LET'S REMEMBER THAT THE LORD PROMISED ABRAHAM

*Genesis 22:17 I will surely bless you, and I will multiply your descendants like the stars in the sky and the sand on the seashore. Your descendants will possess the gates of their enemies!

*Genesis 25:21 Now Isaac pleaded with the Lord for his wife, because she was barren.

*Luke 11:1 Now it came to pass, as He was praying in a certain place, when He ceased, that one of His disciples said to Him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples."

*Luke 3:21 When all the people were baptized, it came to pass that Yeshua also was baptized; and while He prayed, the heaven was opened.

*Matthew 23:14 Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites, because you devour widows' houses, even while for a pretense you make long prayers; therefore you shall receive greater condemnation.

*Luke 18:1 Then Yeshua told them a parable about their need to pray at all times and not lose heart:

*Lamentations 2:19 Arise, sing in the night, at the beginning of the watches.

*Genesis 25:21 Isaac entreated (vayaiatar) the LORD opposite his wife because barren was she. And the LORD allowed Himself to be entreated by Him, and Rebecca his wife conceived.

*Genesis 25:22 But the children struggled together within her; and she said, "If all is well, why am I like this?" So she went to inquire of the Lord.

*Genesis 25:23 And the LORD said to her: "Two nations are in your womb, Two peoples shall be separated from your body; One people shall be stronger than the other, And the older shall serve the younger."

*Genesis 27: 7-18 Bring me game and make savory food for me, that I may eat it and bless you in the presence of the Lord before my death.' ⁸ Now therefore, my son, obey my voice according to what I command you. ⁹ Go now to the flock and bring me from there two choice kids of the goats, and I will make savory food from them for your father, such as he loves. ¹⁰ Then you shall take it to your father, that he may eat it, and that he may bless you before his death.

¹¹ And Jacob said to Rebekah his mother, "Look, Esau my brother is a hairy man, and I am a smooth-skinned man. ¹² Perhaps my father will feel me, and I shall seem to be a deceiver to him; and I shall bring a curse on myself and not a blessing."

¹³ But his mother said to him, "Let your curse be on me, my son; only obey my voice, and go, get them for me." ¹⁴ And he went and got them and brought them to his mother, and his mother made savory food, such as his father loved. ¹⁵ Then Rebekah took the choice clothes of her elder son Esau, which were with her in the house, and put them on Jacob her younger son. ¹⁶ And she put the skins of the kids of the goats on his hands and on the smooth part of his neck. ¹⁷ Then she gave the savory food and the bread, which she had prepared, into the hand of her son Jacob.

¹⁸ So he went to his father and said, "My father."

And he said, "Here I am. Who are you, my son?"

*Genesis 27:21-23 Isaac said to Jacob, "Come closer that I may feel you, my son—whether you are really my son Esau or not." So Jacob drew close to his father Isaac, who felt him and wondered. "The voice is the voice of Jacob, yet the hands are the hands of Esau."

*Isaiah 40:9-10 O Zion, You who bring good tidings, Get up into the high mountain; O Jerusalem, You who bring good tidings, Lift up your voice with strength,

Lift it up, be not afraid; Say to the cities of Judah, "Behold your God!"¹⁰ Behold, the LORD God shall come with a strong hand, And His arm shall rule for Him; Behold, His reward is with Him, And His work before Him.

*Genesis 27:26-28 Then his father Isaac said to him, "Please come near and kiss me, my son." 27 So he came near and kissed him. When Isaac smelled his clothing, he blessed him and said: Ah the smell of my son is like the smell of a field that the LORD has blessed. 28 May God give to you the dew of heaven and the richness of the earth—an abundance of grain and new wine....

*Psalm 2:12 Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, And you perish in the way, When His wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all those who put their trust in Him.

*Ephesians 5:1-2 Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children. And walk in love, as Messiah loved us and gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.

*Revelation 5:8 And when he had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each holding a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints.

*2 Corinthians 2:15 For we are the aroma of Messiah to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing,

*Isaiah 11:3; 10-11..... and he will delight in the fear of the LORD. He will not judge by what he sees with his eyes, or decide by what he hears with his ears; "And in that day there shall be a Root of Jesse, Who shall stand as a banner to the people; For the Gentiles shall seek Him, And His resting place shall be glorious."¹¹ It shall come to pass in that day
That the Lord shall set His hand again the second time
To recover the remnant of His people who are left....

*Numbers 23:9 From the rocky peaks I see them, from the heights I view them. I see a people who live apart and do not consider themselves one of the nations.

*Isaiah 43:21 The people I formed for Myself will declare My praise.
