Exodus 6:2-9:35; Ezeikel 28:25-29:21; Luke 11:14-22

***Shemot/Exodus 3:13-15** Then Moses asked God, "Suppose I go to the Israelites and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they ask me, 'What is His name?' What should I tell them?" **14** God said to Moses, I AM WHO I AM. ***Exodus 20:7** "You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the Lord will not hold him guiltless who takes His name in vain.

***Shemot/Exodus 5:17-19** But he said, "You are idle! Idle! Therefore, you say, 'Let us go and sacrifice to the LORD.' **18** Therefore go now and work; for no straw shall be given you, yet you shall deliver the quota of bricks." **19** And the officers of the children of Israel saw that they were in trouble after it was said, "You shall not reduce any bricks from your daily quota."

***Shemot/Exodus 5:20-21** And they encountered Moses and Aaron standing opposite them, as they left from the presence of Pharaoh. They said to them, May HaShem look upon you and judge, in that you have made our scent foul smelling in the eyes of Pharaoh and in the eyes of his servants, to place a sword in their hands to murder us!

***Shemot/Exodus 3:7-8** And the LORD said: "I have surely seen the oppression of My people who are in Egypt, and have heard their cry because of their taskmasters, for I know their sorrows. ⁸ So I have come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up from that land to a good and large land, to a land flowing with milk and honey,

***I John 4:4** You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world.

***I John 4:3a &5....**And this is the spirit of the antichrist, which you have heard was coming, and is now already in the world.....They are of the world. Therefore, they speak as of the world, and the world hears them.

***Romans 8:1-13** But if Messiah is in you, your body is dead because of sin, yet your spirit is alive because of righteousness. And if the Spirit of Him who raised Yeshua from the dead is living in you, He who raised Messiah Yeshua from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit, who lives in you.

***I John 5:4** For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.

***I John 2:14** I have written to you, fathers, because you have really known the One from the beginning of time and even before time as we know it. I have written to you, younger men, because you really are (spiritually) mighty, robust, and strong, and the word of God steadfastly abides inside you, and you have conquered, mastered, and victoriously overcome the one who is so foul, hostile, impure, malicious, malignant, savage, vicious, and vile.

***Micah 7:15** "As in the days when you came out of the land of Egypt, I will show them wonders."

***2 Peter 3:11-12a** Since everything will be destroyed in this way, what kind of people ought you to be? You ought to conduct yourselves in holiness and godliness as you anticipate and hasten the coming of the day of God.....

***Shemot/Exodus 5:22-23** So Moses returned to the LORD and said, "Lord, why have You brought trouble on this people? Why is it You have sent me? For since I came to Pharaoh to speak in Your name, he has done evil to this people; but rescue, You did not rescue Your people.

***Shemot 6:1-3** Then the LORD said to Moses, "Now you shall see what I will do to Pharaoh. For with a strong hand he will let them go, and with a strong hand he will drive them out of his land." And God spoke to Moses and said to him: "I am the LORD. I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, as God Almighty (El Shaddai), but by My name LORD I was not known to them.

***Exodus 6:2-4** And God spoke to Moses and said to him: "I am the LORD. ³ I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, as El Shaddai, but by My name LORD I was not

known to them. ⁴ I have also established My covenant with them, to give them the land of Canaan, the land of their pilgrimage, in which they were strangers.

***Genesis 12:7** Then the LORD appeared to Abram and said, "To your offspring I will give this land." So he built there an altar to the LORD, who had appeared to him.

***Exodus 6:4** I have also established My covenant with them, to give them the land of Canaan, the land of their pilgrimage, in which they were strangers.

***Genesis 15:13** God said to Abram, Know for certain that your descendants will be strangers in a land that is not theirs, where they will be enslaved and oppressed four hundred years. But I will also judge the nation whom they will serve, and afterward they will come out with many possessions.

***Isaiah 53:6** We all like sheep have gone astray, each one has turned to his own way; and the LORD has laid upon Him the iniquity of us all.

***Romans 5:8** But God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Messiah died for us.

***Hebrews 8:6** Now, however, Yeshua has received a much more excellent ministry, just as the covenant He mediates is better and is founded on better promises.

***Romans 7:12** So then, the law is holy, and the commandment is holy, righteous, and good.

***Romans 3:31** Do we, then, nullify the law by this faith? Certainly not! Instead, we uphold the law.

***Romans 7:7** What then shall we say? Is the law sin? Certainly not! Indeed, I would not have been mindful of sin if not for the law. For I would not have been aware of coveting if the law had not said, "Do not covet."

***Galatians 3:24** The entire law is fulfilled in a single decree: "Love your neighbor as yourself."

***Matthew 5:17-18** Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets. I have not come to abolish them, but to fulfill them. / For I tell you truly, until heaven and earth pass away, not a single jot, not a stroke of a pen, will disappear from the Law until everything is accomplished.

***Hebrews 7:22** by so much more Yeshua has become a surety of a better covenant.

***Galatians 6:2** Bear one another's burdens and you will fulfill the Law of Messiah.

***Exodus 1:17** The midwives, however, feared God and did not do as the king of Egypt had instructed; they let the boys live.
