**How are We Declaring the Story of the End of Days?**  
Apr. 25, 2026; Iyyar 8, 5786  
Lev. 16:1-20:27; Amos 9:7-15; Mk. 12:28-34

**\*Ephesians 2:10** For we are God's handiwork, created in Messiah Yeshua to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

**Leviticus 23:9-11** The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: 'When you come into the land which I give to you, and reap its harvest, then you shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest to the priest.

**\*Leviticus 23:15-16** And from the day on which you bring the offering, you shall count off seven weeks.

**\*Hosea 2:19-20** where God declares, "I will make you my wife; I will be true and faithful; I will show you **constant love and** mercy and make you mine forever".

**\*Hosea 2:2-32** "Plead with your mother, plead— for she is not my wife, and I am not her husband— that she put away her whoring from her face, and her adultery from between her breasts; lest I strip her naked and make her as in the day she was born, and make her like a wilderness, and make her like a parched land, and kill her with thirst.

**\*Leviticus 23:15-16** "And you shall count for yourselves from the day after the Sabbath, from the day that you brought the sheaf of the wave offering: seven Sabbaths shall be completed. Count fifty days to the day after the seventh Sabbath; then you shall offer a new grain offering to the Lord."

**\*Exodus 20:18-19** When all the people witnessed the thunder and lightning, the sounding of the ram's horn, and the mountain enveloped in smoke, they trembled and stood at a distance. 19Speak to us yourself and we will listen, they said to Moses. But do not let God speak to us, or we will die.

**\*Acts 2:1-4** "When the Day of Pentecost (Shavuot) had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind... And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance."

**\*John 14:15-16** If you love Me, you will keep My commandments. **16** And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Advocate to be with you forever - 17the Spirit of truth. The world cannot receive Him, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him. But you do know Him, for He abides with you and will be in you...

\*John 20:16; Matthew 28:9; Luke 24 13-30 --- John 21; Luke 24:34; John 20:26-29; --- John 21:1-14; I Corinthians 15:6; I Corinthians 15:7; --- Acts 1:3-12

**\*Leviticus 19:2** Speak to the entire congregation of the children of Israel, and say to them: You shall be holy, for I the LORD your God am holy.

**\*Deuteronomy 12:30-31** take heed to yourself that you are not ensnared to follow them, after they are destroyed from before you, and that you do not inquire after their gods, saying, 'How did these nations serve their gods? I also will do likewise.' <sup>31</sup> You shall not worship the Lord your God in that way; for every abomination to the LORD which He hates they have done to their gods; for they burn even their sons and daughters in the fire to their gods.

**\*Deuteronomy 20:18** lest they teach you to do according to all their abominations which they have done for their gods, and you sin against the LORD your God.

**\*John 8:28-29** "A disciple is not above his teacher, but everyone when he is fully trained will be like his teacher".

**\*John 14:9** He who has seen Me has seen the Father.

**\*Genesis 18:1** The Holy One, blessed be He, visited the sick, as it is written 'Now the LORD appeared to him by the oaks of Mamre' [while he was still recovering from circumcision],

**\*Genesis 25:11** After the death of Abraham, that God blessed his son Isaac,

**\*Deuteronomy 34:6** And He buried him in the valley in the land of Moab,

**\*Matthew 25:35-36** For I was hungry and you gave Me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave Me something to drink, I was a stranger and you took Me in, I was naked and you clothed me. I was sick and you took care of Me, I was in prison and you visited Me.

**\*John 8:28-29** A disciple is not above his teacher, but everyone when he is fully trained will be like his teacher.

**\*Exodus 13:8** You shall tell your son on that day, It is because of what the LORD did for me when I came out of Egypt.

\***Matthew 24:42,44:** "Therefore keep watch, because you do not know on what day your Lord will come... the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect".

\***Revelation 22:12:** "And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work".

\***Acts 1:10-11** They were looking intently into the sky as He was going, when suddenly two men dressed in white stood beside them. 11Men of Galilee, they said, why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Yeshua, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen Him go into heaven.

\***Acts 2:17-21** And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, That I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your young men shall see visions, Your old men shall dream dreams. <sup>18</sup> And on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days; And they shall prophesy. <sup>19</sup> I will show wonders in heaven above And signs in the earth beneath: Blood and fire and vapor of smoke. <sup>20</sup> The sun shall be turned into darkness, And the moon into blood, Before the coming of the great and awesome day of the Lord.

\***Acts 3:1-7** <sup>1</sup>Now Peter and John went up together to the temple at the hour of prayer, the ninth hour. <sup>2</sup> And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms from those who entered the temple; <sup>3</sup> who, seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple, asked for alms. <sup>4</sup> And fixing his eyes on him, with John, Peter said, "Look at us." <sup>5</sup> So he gave them his attention, expecting to receive something from them. <sup>6</sup> Then Peter said, "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: In the name of Yeshua HaMashiach of Nazareth, rise up and walk." <sup>7</sup> And he took him by the right hand and lifted him up, and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength. <sup>8</sup> So he, leaping up, stood and walked and entered the temple with them-

\***Acts 4:1-31** Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word, <sup>30</sup> by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Yeshua." <sup>31</sup> And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.

\***Numbers 23:9** For from the top of the rocks I see him, And from the hills I behold him; There! A people dwelling alone, Not reckoning itself among the nations.

\***Isaiah 53:3** and selected words and phrases - He was despised and rejected, a Man of sorrows, He was despised and we did not esteem him, afflicted, wounded.....

\***Hebrews 13:13** Therefore let us go to Him outside the camp, bearing the disgrace He bore.

**\*Leviticus 13:46** "He shall remain unclean as long as he has the disease; he is unclean. He shall live alone; his dwelling shall be outside the camp".

**\*Deuteronomy 32:12** So the LORD alone led him, And there was no foreign god with him.

**\*Numbers 23:9** For from the top of the rocks I see him, And from the hills I behold him; There! A people dwelling alone,

**\*Numbers 24:7** He shall pour water from his buckets, And his seed shall be in many waters. "His king shall be higher than Agag, And his kingdom shall be exalted.

**\*Philippians 2:9-11** ...Therefore God exalted Him to the highest place and gave Him the name above all names, <sup>10</sup>that at the name of Yeshua every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <sup>11</sup>and every tongue confess that Yeshua HaMasshiach is Lord, to the glory of God the Father....
