Deut. 26:1-29:9; Isa 60:1-22; Mt. 4:13-24

***Deuteronomy 26:1** And it shall be, when you come into the land which the Lord your God is giving you as an inheritance, and you possess it and dwell in it,

***Joel 3:2** I will gather all nations and bring them down to the Valley of Jehoshaphat. There I will enter into judgment against them concerning My people, My inheritance, Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations as they divided up My land.

***Psalm 2:1-4** Why do the nations rage, and the people plot a vain thing? ² The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD and against His Anointed saying, ³ "Let us break Their bonds in pieces and cast away Their cords from us." ⁴ He who sits in the heavens shall laugh; the LORD shall hold them in derision.

***Acts 5:39** But if God is behind it, you cannot stop it anyway, unless you want to fight against God. The council members agreed with what he said,

***Psalm 2:10-12** Now therefore, be wise, O kings; Be instructed, you judges of the earth. ¹¹ Serve the Lord with fear, and rejoice with trembling. ¹² Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, and you perish in the way, when His wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all those who put their trust in Him.

***Jeremiah 17:7** Blessed is the man who trusts in the LORD. He is like a tree planted by water, that sends out its roots by the stream and does not fear when heat comes, for its leaves remain green, and it is not anxious in the year of drought, for it does not cease to bear fruit.

***Deuteronomy 26:1** And it shall be, when you come into the land which the LORD your God is giving you as an inheritance, and you possess it and dwell in it,

***Isaiah 41:8** But you, Israel, my servant, Jacob, whom I have chosen, you descendants of Abraham my friend.

***Deuteronomy 26:5-10** And you shall answer and say before the LORD your God: My father was an Arminian, about to perish, and he went down to Egypt and dwelt there, few in number; and there he became a nation, great, mighty, and populous. ⁶ But the Egyptians mistreated us, afflicted us, and laid hard bondage on us. ⁷ Then we cried out to the LORD God of our fathers, and the LORD heard our voice and looked on our affliction and our labor and our oppression. ⁸ So the LORD brought us out of Egypt with a mighty hand and with an outstretched arm, with great terror and with signs and wonders. ⁹ He has brought us to this place and has given us this land, "a land flowing with milk and honey"; ¹⁰ and now, behold, I have brought the firstfruits of the land which you, O LORD, have given me.

***Ephesians 2:11-16** Therefore remember that you, once Gentiles in the flesh—who are called Uncircumcision by what is called the Circumcision made in the flesh by hands— ¹² that at that time you were without Mashiach, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. ¹³ But now in Yeshua HaMashiach you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Mashiach. ¹⁴ For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation, ¹⁵ having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace, ¹⁶ and that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity.

***Matthew 4:15-16** The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, by the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles: The people who sat in darkness have seen a great light, and upon those who sat in the region and shadow of death light has dawned.

***Revelation 7:1a** After these things I saw four angels standing at the four corners of the earth,

***Revelation 7:4** And I heard the number of those who were sealed. One hundred and forty-four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel were sealed:

***Revelation 7:9-17 Selections** After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands, ¹⁰ and crying out with a loud voice, saying, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!" ¹³ Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, Who are these arrayed in white robes, and where did they come from? ¹⁴ And I said to him, Sir, you know.

So he said to me, These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. ¹⁵ Therefore they are before

the throne of God and serve Him day and night in His temple. And He who sits on the throne will dwell among them.....And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.

***Genesis 48:17-20** When Joseph saw his father placing his right hand on Ephraim's head he was displeased; so he took hold of his father's hand to move it from Ephraim's head to Manasseh's head. ¹⁸ Joseph said to him, "No, my father, this one is the firstborn; put your right hand on his head."

¹⁹ But his father refused and said, "I know, my son, I know. He too will become a people, and he too will become great. Nevertheless, his younger brother will be greater than he, and his descendants will become many nations." ²⁰ He blessed them that day and said,

In your^l name will Israel pronounce this blessing:
May God make you like Ephraim and Manasseh.

So he put Ephraim ahead of Manasseh.

***Hosea 7:8,9a-** "Ephraim has mixed himself among the peoples; Ephraim is a cake unturned. ⁹ Aliens have devoured his strength, but he does not know it;¹⁰ And the pride of Israel testifies to his face, but they do not return to the LORD their God,
Nor seek Him for all this.

***Hosea 9:3** They shall not remain in the LORD's land; but Ephraim shall return to Egypt, and they shall eat unclean food in Assyria.

***Jeremiah 31:9** They will come with weeping; they will pray as I bring them back. I will lead them beside streams of water on a level path where they will not stumble, because I am Israel's father, and Ephraim is my firstborn son.

***Isaiah 9:7** Of the greatness of his government and peace there will be no end. He will reign on David's throne, and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever.

***Isaiah 45:3** I will give you the treasures of darkness and hidden riches of secret places, that you may know that I, the LORD, Who call you by your name, Am the God of Israel.

***Jeremiah 31:15** Thus says the LORD: A voice was heard in Ramah, Lamentation and bitter weeping, Rachel weeping for her children, Refusing to be comforted for her children, because

***Revelation 7:17** For the Lamb at the center of the throne will be their shepherd; he will lead them to springs of living water, and God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.

***Romans 11:25-27** For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that blindness in part has happened

to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in. ²⁶ And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: The Deliverer will come out of Zion, and He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob; ²⁷ for this is My covenant with them, When I take away their sins.

***Isaiah 60:4** Lift up your eyes all around, and see: they all gather together, they come to you; your sons shall come from afar, and your daughters shall be nursed at your side.

***Isaiah 60:14b,19b,20,21a,22** And all those who despised you shall fall prostrate at the soles of your feet; And they shall call you The City of the LORD, Zion of the Holy One of Israel."..... For the LORD will be your everlasting light, And the days of your mourning shall be ended. Also your people shall all be righteous; They shall inherit the land forever, The branch of My planting, The work of My hands, That I may be glorified.....

I, the LORD, will hasten it in its time.
